

Pickleball Rules for Lagoon

1. Pickleball can only be played between the hours of 10am – 2pm daily to help reduce the noise impact on the community. As such, pickleball play has precedence over any tennis that could otherwise be played between 10am – 2pm. Tennis players must yield the court to waiting pickleball players at the end of their current GAME.
2. If players are waiting, the losing team on a pickleball court shall surrender the court at the end of the current game to 11. If more than 2 are waiting, the players with the first two paddles in the stack go first.
3. Only approved quiet paddles may be used. (See list of approved paddles). If you do not have quiet paddles, then you are not allowed to play. This is in consideration of those who live close to the court.
4. Pickleball players shall deploy the net(s) for play and return them to storage after play.
5. A warning and fines will be given for not complying.
6. Show respect for all
7. The HOA expects to sponsor friendly get-together pickleball “tournaments.”
